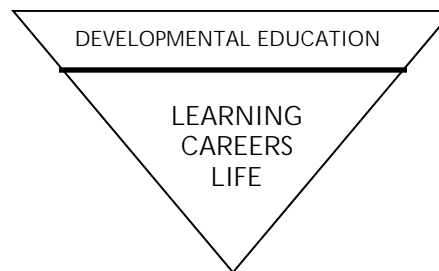

### WHAT IS IT?

The Developmental Education Curriculum is a comprehensive resource of activities to supplement current classroom instruction across the curriculum and for the purpose of developing students' learning, life, and career skills.

This flexible curriculum is sequential and developmentally appropriate for each designated grade level (PreK-12) and includes classroom ready activities in both hard copy and electronic form with suggestions for discussions and student and teacher evaluations.

The curriculum is based on goals and competencies developed by the Illinois Counseling Association in cooperation with the Illinois State Board of Education using the National Career Development Guidelines. The competencies, the ISBE Learning Standards & Social/Emotional Learning Standards are crosswalked.

### HOW IS IT TO BE USED?

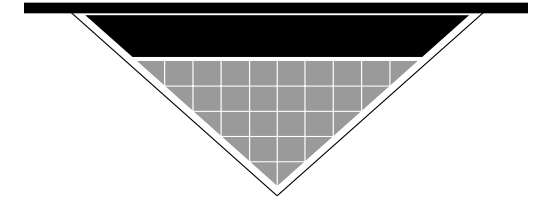
This is an easy-to-use curriculum requiring little preparation time. The activities are to be used by educators who identify needs in the academic, career, and social development of their students.
